- Sasha Brut Sparkling** - Pyrenees, Vic (NV) 9/40
A fresh, elegant Sparkling with a long and creamy finish.
- Lana Prosecco** - King Valley, Vic (2012) 45
A fine, dry version of the Italian classic. Perfect as an aperitif.
- Blue Pyenees Midnight Cuvee** - Pyrenees, Vic (2011) 60
This flagship 'Methode Traditionnelle' Sparkling wine displays all the things you want from a fine French Champagne without the price tag. Go on ... Spoil yourself!
- Campbells Moscato 500ml** - Rutherglen, Vic (2014) 9/34
Brilliant, light salmon pink. A light, fresh and fabulous wine to enjoy anytime.

THE WHITE KNIGHTS

- Gapsted 'Valley Selection' Riesling** - King Valley, Vic (2014) 40
The great thing about Riesling from the cool climate areas of the King Valley is that it is so well balanced. The nutrition levels in the fruit and the acid balance means the winemakers do very little when turning it into wine, it does it all by itself.
- Pizzini Sauvignon Blanc** - Yarra Valley, Vic (2014) 9.5/42
Here you'll smell wild mountain grasses, fresh cut herbs and fresh tropical fruits. The palate has tangy, crisp appeal with green apple and Tahitian lime flavours.
- Route du Van Sauvignon Blanc Semillion** - Yarra Valley, Vic (2013) 45
Jump in your van and travel all over the country side, then kick back and enjoy this light refreshing crisp and fruity drop in the sun.
- Delatite 'Dead Man's Hill' Gewurtztraminer** - Mansfield, Vic (2013) 48
This wine is so good James Halliday scored it a whopping 96 points. Completely dry with a long clean finish it goes great with any aromatic or spicy dishes we may be plating up.
- Ferryman Pinot Gris** - Mornington Peninsula, Vic (2013) 10.5/46
Full and ripe with pears, citrus fruits & spice. A beautifully crafted wine which will really bring you up.
- San Pietro Pinot Grigio** - Mornington Peninsula, Vic (2014) 39
A distinctly vibrant wine with pear & citrus flavours & solid acidity.
- Yarra Peaks Estate 'Little Rascal' Arneis** - Yarra Valley, Vic (2014) 9/40
An Italian varietal that is really starting to make it's mark on the Australian wine scene. Arneis, literally meaning little rascal, is a crisp textured wine with hints of almonds and pears.
- Feathertop Vermentino** - Alpine Valleys, Vic (2013) 47
Scored 94 points from James Halliday which is the highest ever for this variety. With tropical fruit flavours this wine sits somewhere between a Sauvignon Blanc and a Chardonnay.
- Seville Estate 'Barber' Chardonnay** - Yarra Valley, Vic (2014) 9.5/42
A full bodied, elegant wine, rich in the aromas of melon & apricot fruit. This wine dances on the palate with lashing of sweet spice & toasty oak.
- Medhurst Chardonnay** - Yarra Valley, Vic (2012) 52
Melons & figs, sweet nougat, oak, woodspice & a hint of caramel. If you're after flavour, look no further.
- Caledonia Australis Chardonnay** - South Gippsland, Vic (2012) 56
Do yourself a favour and get around this wine. Unbelievable!
- Harcourt Valley Rosé** - Bendigo, Vic (2014) 9/40
Bright salmon in colour, pale but complex. This Grenache Rosé is laced with bright sour cherry, lavender and spiced redcurrants. Long and savoury with bright acidity and considerable length.
